HISTORY OF CHEP





End of WW II - US Army leaves behind a wealth of materials handling equipment at their military bases in Australia.

1945

Commonwealth Handling Equipment Pool

Australian government combines this asset base with existing infrastructure to form the Commonwealth Handling Equipment Pool

1949 Privatize CHEP

The government decides to privatize the equipment-handling organization now known simply as CHEP.

1958 Brambles acquires CHEP

Brambles, a business formed in 1875 with experience in materials handling, acquires CHEP.

CHEP POOLING

Pallet pooling is based on the principle of the circular economy. You do not buy pallets to exchange, but rent them and share them with other companies.

You outsource your entire pallet management and you also eliminate the hidden costs and you are sure that the pallets delivered meet the required quality standards.




